We look forward to seeing your student at the Alabama Youth in Government Judicial Conference. This year, Youth Judicial will take place November 12-14 at the Federal Courthouse in downtown Montgomery (1 Church Street) and the Renaissance Hotel (201 Tallapoosa Street).

Registration will be 9:00 am - 11:45 am Saturday morning at the Renaissance Hotel where we will be staying for the weekend. Lunch will not be provided on Saturday. Everyone who is registered will be provided with supper Saturday night and lunch on Sunday. A Montgomery School is offering breakfast for advance purchase. School Advisors have been provided the information to arrange that if they wish. Sunday Night's meal is not provided. Participants will be given time to go and eat at the restaurants around the hotel, in the hotel restaurant, or order delivery.

This year decorum will be extremely important because trials will be held in the Federal Courthouse. The only thing your student will be able to bring into the courthouse is their trial material. Absolutely no knives, mace, scissors, fingernail files, or anything that could be construed as a weapon are allowed. **Also, no student, parent, or advisor will be allowed to bring cell phones or other electronic devices in the courthouse.** Please see the full list of Decorum Guidelines at www.alyig.org/judicial.
