We look forward to seeing all of you at the Alabama Youth in Government Judicial Conference. This year, Youth Judicial will take place November 12-14 at the Federal Courthouse in downtown Montgomery (1 Church Street) and the Renaissance Hotel (201 Tallapoosa Street).

Registration will be 9:00 am - 11:45 am Saturday morning at the Renaissance Hotel where we will be staying for the weekend. Lunch will not be provided on Saturday. Everyone who is registered will be provided with supper Saturday night and lunch on Sunday. You will be given time to go and eat at the restaurants around the hotel, in the hotel, or order delivery. Please discuss with your advisor your options for meals.

This year decorum will be extremely important because trials will be held in the Federal Courthouse. Please see the full list of Decorum Guidelines at www.alyig.org/judicial. The only thing you will be able to bring into the courthouse is your trial material. Absolutely no knives, mace, scissors, fingernail files, or anything that could be construed as a weapon are allowed. All of your team's material will have to fit into a standard sized paper box that will be provided to your Team Captain. Refrain from wearing/bringing lots of metallic jewelry, large belt buckles, etc. that will hamper you from walking through the metal detectors.

Also, you, your parents, or your advisor will NOT be allowed to bring cell phones or any other electronic device in the courthouse. If there is an emergency and your parents need to contact you, they can call the YMCA Conference Hotline at 334-220-9622.

Your parents are welcomed and encouraged to come and watch you in the competition.
