1. At least a sophomore in High School, in the year position is actually held.

E. Qualifications of Attorney General

1. At least a sophomore in High School
2. **Attorney General** – Numbers 2 through 8 as stated above in "A"

F. Qualifications of Chaplains, Secretary of Senate, Clerk of the House, Reading Clerks, Asst. Sec. of the State, Deputy Attorney General and Sgt. at Arms

1. Ability to speak in public.
2. In any high school grade (9-12).
3. Recognized leadership.
4. Member of an affiliated Hi-Y, Tri-Hi-Y or Government Club.
